HOW TO BE TANGIBLE SIGNS OF HOPE

What we plan to do: Engage parishioners in parishes across our diocese to package ONE MILLION nutritional meals for the poor. These are high nutrition, easy to prepare meal packs (six meals in a bag). This highly successful event will be the fourth annual Million Meal Event.

How will we do it?

Annually, we partner with the nonprofit organization, KIDS AROUND THE WORLD (KATW), and this year, we are joined by CATHOLIC CHARITIES OF DIOCESE OF SAN DIEGO (CCDSD). KATW provides the raw materials and supply the equipment we need for the event. Million Meal Event organizing team from the DEACONS OF SAN DIEGO provides the volunteers and donations to buy food! CCDSD provides support with volunteer signups, publicity and donation tracking.

Where will the meals go? The one million packed meals go to hungry children and families in Baja, California, served by CASA DE LOS POBRES, and to the poor in AFRICA served by Kids Around the World.

How many volunteers do we need?

In total, we need 3,000 VOLUNTEERS for a successful event! We hope that each parish can bring at least 50 people to the event. **We'll** package meals in two shifts: 8:30-11 and 12:30-3 PM on Saturday, June 14. Signups are ongoing now on the website: www.ccdsd.org/million-meals-event/

How much does it cost to do this project?

We will need to raise \$300,000 which is the cost of the raw materials, equipment rental for the event, and the transportation to get meals to the people in need.

How will we raise the money?

If each parish can raise JUST \$5,000 or more, this helps accomplish our collective goal! Families or groups can sponsor a box of meals, or can sponsor an aspect of the project, such as one of the packaging tables. Additionally, as volunteers sign up, they will be given an opportunity to make a donation to help cover the cost of the food.

Who can help? Everybody!!

Build a team of friends and family to help package meals, raise money for supplies, and organize a group to participate in the fun day of Million Meal Event on June 14th at Cathedral High School! This is a great event for families, small church communities, confirmation classes, classrooms, and everyone in the parish.

On packaging day, we can all be the HANDS OF CHRIST!

I AM A PASTOR OR DEACON OF A PARISH. WHAT CAN I DO?

- 1. This is a team effort among Pastors and Deacons. This is an event sponsored and promoted by the Deacons and wives of the Diocese of San Diego. In partnership with the Office for Permanent Diaconate and Catholic Charities of the Diocese of San Diego, all parishes, schools, and church lay movements and organizations of San Diego can bring hope to come alive!
- 2. Announce the event in your parish:
 - Bulletin Announcements (Flyer included)
 - Mass Announcements It always helps to hear the pastor speak about this event as an excellent way to encourage participation.
 - Flocknote announcements from the parish
 - Parish Social Media announcements
- 3. Develop a Parish Leadership Team to:
 - Help organize from the parish level
 - Help raise fund and reach our \$300,000 goal and set your own parish goal
 - Help recruit and sign-up volunteers
- 4. Recruit and sign-up volunteers on the MME Website www.ccdsd.org/million-meals-event/
- 5. Fundraise for the Event
 - Pastor and deacon collaborate and be creative on how this can be done.
 - We need to raise \$300,000 (\$0.27/meal, plus other expenses)
 - We need all parishes to participate in the event
 - This is approximately \$5,000 per parish
 - Smaller parish may raise less, but larger parishes can raise more
- 6. Manifest in each one the heart of Diakonia --- the heart of service and ministry --- and through the help of our pastors and deacons, help guide the people of God in our parishes to engage more deeply into the mystery of the service of charity.


