# LITURGY

What are the requirements?

How long does it take to complete the certificate? The Certificate requires successful completion of at least 270 clock hours of course work and a 30-hour practicum.

The certificate is useful for RCIA teams, trainers of liturgical ministers, and Catholic school teachers.

Students must attend classes, complete reading and assignments, participate in discussion, and take exams for a grade of "C–" or better, or earn a "Pass."

Tuition runs from \$35 to \$75, depending on length of course. Discounts are available for auditors and groups of four or more. Cost of books is extra for each course.

Courses are held primarily in the evening, year-round, at parish and diocesan sites. Schedules and registration are online.

Taking one course at at time, one evening per week, requires approximately three years. Certificate-seekers also may go at their own pace, taking fewer courses per year and longer to finish.

### What courses do I need?

Completion of the Certificate requires at least 270 clock hours taken for credit via the following Institute courses:

## How do I arrange to complete the practicum?

A supervised practicum of 30 hours must be completed under the direction of the diocesan Office for Liturgy and Spirituality. The certificate seeker should contact the Diocesan Institute to design a suitable practicum to be completed prior to granting the certificate.
