## THE FEAST OF THE MARTYRS OF VIETNAM

The Vietnamese Catholic Community of San Diego cordially invites the Diocesan Cultural Communities, Leaders and Friends, and Vietnamese Congregrations to celebrate the Feast of Saint Andrew Dung-Lac and Companions, Vietnamese Martyrs.

The feast of the Martyrs of Vietnam will be celebrated at Good Shepherd Catholic Church on Sunday, November 16, 2025. The feast day honors the 117 faith leaders and unknown companions killed in Vietnam and canonized by Pope John Paul II in 1988.

It is estimated that countless Catholics in Vietnam were persecuted and as many as 300,000 killed beginning in the late 18th century and lasting more than 60 years. These include Saint Andrew Dũng-Lạc, and 21 missionaries from France and Spain, slain in Vietnam. Since the group was canonized, Vietnamese Catholics have held annual ceremonies to commemorate the martyrs.
