RE: 2024 Rite of Election and Call to Continuing Conversion

In anticipation of the upcoming celebration for the Rite of Election and Call to Continuing Conversion, please take note of the following:

FOR PARISHES ATTENDING A DIOCESAN RITE OF ELECTION AND CALL TO CONTINUING CONVERSION:

- ✦ The Rite of Sending is celebrated in the parish at a suitable time prior to the ROE. (RCIA, 108)
- ✦ Parishes participating in a Diocesan Rite of Election on Saturday, February 17th may consider celebrating the Rite of Sending at your Parish on Saturday morning, February 17th.
- ✦ Parishes participating in one of the Diocesan Rites on Sunday, February 18th may consider celebrating the Rite of Sending, at the Vigil Mass on Saturday, February 17th or at a Sunday Morning Mass on February 18th.
- ✦ The Rite of Sending takes place after the homily in a celebration of a Liturgy of the Word or Mass. (RCIA,128)
- ✦ For only catechumens, use the Rite of Sending Catechumens for Election: (RCIA, 111-116)
- ✦ For both catechumens and candidates, use the Combined Rite for Sending Catechumens for Election and Candidates for Recognition by the Bishop: (RCIA, 530-546)
- ✦ The Rite of Election and the Call Continuing Conversion may be celebrated at a later date in your parish during a community celebration of a Liturgy of the Word or a Mass for those that missed the Diocesan Rite due to illness. See below.

FOR PARISHES NOT ATTENDING A DIOCESAN RITE OF ELECTION AND CALL TO CONTINUING CONVERSION:

- ✦ The Rite of Sending is not celebrated if the Right of Election and Call to Continuing Conversion (ROE) is celebrated at your parish.
- ✦ The signing of the Book of the Elect takes place during your parish ROE.
- ✦ The pastor, as the Bishop's delegate, will sign the Book of the Elect. (RCIA, 548)
- ✦ The ROE may be celebrated during a Liturgy of the Word or during Mass. (RCIA, 128)
- ✦ When the rite is celebrated within Mass, the rite takes place after the homily, and should be celebrated within the Mass of the First Sunday of Lent (RCIA, 128)

- ✦ When celebrated outside Mass, the rite takes place after the readings and the homily and is concluded with the dismissal of both the elect and the faithful. (RCIA, 128)
- ✦ For an Order of Service for ROE within Mass on the First Sunday of Lent, a script for ROE within Mass in English and Spanish, and a script for ROE within a Liturgy of the Word can be found here: www.sdcatholic.org/roe
- ✦ Another rite may be celebrated at a later date during a community celebration of a Liturgy of the Word or a Mass for those catechumens that missed the parish Rite of Election due to illness.
